Description:

Mobilize the campaign to end child labour in informal sector and child trafficking. This will be achieved with the support of AATWIN 41 member organizations. We will conduct the various activities related to awareness raising, sensitization and capacity building of member organizations as well other stakeholders. AATWIN will also advocate for policy change and improvement of the related mechanisms.

Implementation plan:

AATWIN, as a national level network against human trafficking, will implement the actions with its 41 Member organizations as well other CSO and Govt. agencies.

AATWIN is the Chairperson of NACG' Nepal National Action and Coordinating Group to End Violence against Children (NACG), established in each South Asian Country (Afghanistan, Bangladesh, Bhutan, India, Maldives, Nepal, Pakistan, & Sri Lanka). Linkages are developed with the regional South Asia Coordinating Group on Action against Violence against Women and Children (SACG). The purpose is to strengthen inter-agency work including governments and children groups to end violence against children, including child trafficking. NACG Nepal supports and collaborates with the SAIEVAC (a SAARC Apex body) Governing Board Members/ Coordinator and National SAIEVAC Mechanisms. It has 17 member networks working on child rights. AATWIN will contribute to the various policy intervention related to child labour as it is one of the major themes of NACG Nepal.

Impact:

AATWIN, as a network, is a member of the National Coordinating Committee for Controlling Human Trafficking (NCCHT)/Ministry of Women, Children and Senior Citizen (MoWCSC), National Child Right Commission, National Human Right Commission, Nepal SDG Forum. It is also a member of Alliance 8.7, which will contribute to ending child labour.
