Action to eliminate child labour in mining sites in Lwalaba Province

Name:

Action to eliminate child labour at mining sites in Lwalaba Province, in the Democratic Republic of Congo

Description:

Within 7 months, guide 500 women, and their children, working in and around the Lenge mining site towards non-mining income-generating activities, through training on entrepreneurship, savings and access to microcredit from a local microfinance institution.

Implementation plan:

- Identify potential beneficiaries of this action (May 2021);
- Recruit trainer and set up training on entrepreneurship and the rights of the children, with 25 women per class (June-July 2021);
- Produce and give beneficiary women savings education kits (May-August 2021);
- Draw up business plans with the women to submit to partner microfinance institutions (July 2021);
- For the benefit of the women trained, open saving and credit accounts at the partner microfinance institution for women to deposit their savings and receive credit (August 2021);
- Financing non-mining income-generating activities by the beneficiary women (October 2021);
- Assistance in the process of launching and managing activities (October-November 2021).
- Follow up-assessment: December 2021.

Impact:

Reducing the risk of children being present in mining sites in the Democratic Republic of Congo.
