Description:

Ghana plans to evaluate the National Plan of Action for the Elimination of the Worst Forms of Child Labour (NPA2 2017-2021). The deadline for the implementation of the NPA (2017-2021) is approaching, at the end of 2021. There is therefore the need to assess the results achieved and to develop a new framework for the years to come in order to continue to sustain the momentum and consolidate successes chalked.

Implementation plan:

A consultant will be engaged to lead the review exercise. The Consultant will undertake the following activities:

1. Carry out a desk review (documentation, reports, etc.);
2. Undertake stakeholder engagements (interview, FGD, survey, etc.);
3. Organise consultative workshops;
4. Draft Assessment Report and validate workshops;
5. Draft NPA3 and organise validation workshops.

Impact:

The review will enable the country to take stock of what has been done since the adoption of NPA2, good lessons, strategies that worked, where attention needs to intensify, challenges and strategies to prioritise in the design of the next plan.
