Support for the implementation of a national plan to prevent and eliminate child labour

Description:

A multi-stakeholder plan that translates the desire to ensure the coherence and complementarity of the implementation of the plan and to offer a strategic commitment to boost existing solutions and create new identification and intervention measures and procedures. The plan will follow a results-based approach.

A participatory dynamic that ensures a permanent search for a better coordination between the multiple stakeholders and partners at various levels (national/local) to boost the complementarity of existing schemes and to ensure good "coverage" and promote the smooth flow of the dissemination of information.

Make the PLAN a lever for the protection of childhood.

Two approaches will be used for a strategic orientation:

1 - Curative approach to deal with situations of child labour

- Knowledge, targeting and interventionism.
- Exploration and investigation for better knowledge of the problem, identification and targeting of areas of intervention
- Standardization and updating of legal and regulatory texts
- The implementation of mechanisms that allow better coordination and participation of actors in the fight against child labour
- The division of work and responsibilities between partners

2 - Preventive approach to eliminate all forms of child labour

- Thinking about the problems in all of its dimensions
- Dealing with the root causes that lead to the economic exploitation of children
- Improvement of working conditions / Reintegration into formal education
- Presence of a communication strategy that allows a broad circulation of information

Implementation plan:

The following is necessary to create an action plan to eliminate child labour in Djibouti:

- Set up a national committee
- Identify a national and international consultant to produce it
- Organize an approval workshop

Impact:

This expected impact of this plan is to contribute to eliminating child labour in Djibouti through a suitable legislative environment, strengthened monitoring and repression capacities, improved knowledge of the issue of child labour while private sectors commitments are respected. The implementation of this pledge will also lead to a greater presence of children in schools and broader awareness-raising of the issue of child labour. Finally, this pledge will help the social and economic rehabilitation of victims (families and children).
