Description:

The issue highlighted in Samoa is the prevalence of hazardous child street vending. Children are put in high-risk situations and environments and require joint efforts by both Government and local business leaders.

Implementation plan:

1. In 2021, to finalize the passage of key labour legislation to amend the minimum age for admission to employment in line with Convention No. 138
2. To organize and complete National Follow-up Rapid Assessment of Child Street Vendors in 2021;
3. To organize a Samoa national conference on the elimination of child labour and develop and approve National Action Plan to eliminate Child Labour
