Trinidad and Tobago pledge to support and protect our nation's children and free them from all forms of Child Labour.

Description:

The Pledge put forward by Trinidad and Tobago consists of the action areas being undertaken by members of the National Steering Committee for the Prevention and Elimination of Child Labour of Trinidad and Tobago which comprise partners from Government and Non-Government Organizations. Sub-committees have been formed for each action area and each committee presents the updates and progress being made on a monthly basis. The beneficiaries of the Pledges are children of Trinidad and Tobago, whom the Ministry of Labour is seeking to protect, and the national population, whom we are seeking to empower and educate on the issues surrounding Child Labour, towards its prevention and elimination. To accomplish these goals, the Ministry of Labour has embarked on a series of collaborative, sensitization and institutional strengthening activities.

Implementation plan:

- The development and implementation of a six (6) step strategic compliance model for the Labour Inspectorate Unit in Trinidad and Tobago
- The Establishment of a Child Labour Protocol
- The development of a light and hazardous work list by sector
- The development of a situational analysis and conduct of a data mapping exercise
- The Conduct of primary research by a consultant to assess the situation of Child Labour in Trinidad and Tobago
- Collaboration with Key Government and Non-Government Agencies
- Development of a National Action Plan for Child Labour
