### **Name:**

1. Conference on combating child labour in ASEAN/Southeast Asia
2. The use of the curriculum on child rights and child

### **Description:**

1. Organization of an international online and onsite conference on combating child labour in ASEAN: Law and practice
2. The use of the curriculum on child rights and child labour in the master programme on human rights of VNU School of Law, which ENHANCE supported

### **Implementation plan:**

1. The conference will be co-hosted by three institutions with support from the ENHANCE project, ILO Hanoi
  - a. Vietnam National University, School of Law (VNU-LS)
  - b. Southeast Asian Human Rights Studies Network (SEAHRN)
  - c. Strengthening Human Rights and Peace research and education in Southeast Asia (SHAPE-SEA)
2. The VNU School of Law will use the curriculum on child rights and child labour in its master programme on human rights in Vietnam, which ENHANCE supported. A textbook on combating child labour will be published in 2021.

### **Impact:**

- Contribute to the development and implementation of a ASEAN roadmap to end child labour, with timebound achievable milestones and suggested resource allocations
- Assist ASEAN Governments in drafting new legislation and/or guidelines to promote public procurement as an instrument to fight child labour
- Contribute to advocate a regional campaign to ratify C138 and secure ratifications from countries in the region by the end of 2021
