Description:

Our pledge is to launch an internal awareness-raising campaign within all our territorial structures and sectoral federations in the union movement in Spain on the content of target 8.7, accompanied by an event (date to be determined) where the different actions carried out by CCOO will be shared. The action will be accompanied by dissemination on our usual channels and social networks to multiply its impact. We are also planning to participate in November 2021 in the Simposio Internacional sobre Trabajo Infantil y su Erradicación (International Symposium on Child Labour and its Eradication) in the framework of Target 8.7 of the 2030 Agenda: plural issues, organized by the Carlos III University of Madrid, which we will include in our activities to raise awareness and disseminate contents to our territorial and sectoral organizations.

Implementation plan:

- develop ad hoc materials for an awareness-raising campaign;
- disseminate information and raise awareness among the territorial and sectoral structures of CCOO in Spain on the eradication of child labour;
- organize an event/seminar to share knowledge on the subject, actions carried out and possible multiplier actions;
- participate in ad hoc academic spaces in 2021 in coordination with the ILO.

Impact:

By structuring an engagement action such as this one, our trade union confederation hopes to be able to globally coordinate actions that are already taking place on the ground, raise awareness in those cases where this is still necessary and multiply the impact of our action among our member organizations and workers in Spain.
