National Action Plan for Combating the Worst Forms of Child Labour

Description:

The National Action Plan for Combating the Worst Forms of Child Labour consists of a series of interventions directed to preventing children from being victims of labour exploitation and of the worst forms of child labour, by removing and rehabilitating them and protecting children below the legal minimum age who are working, from exploitation in dangerous jobs.

Implementation plan:

Through actions integrated with different stakeholders, public and private, the activities of which are described in the plan matrix, based on indicators, goals and deadlines

Impact:

The various measures adopted – like free basic education and the removal of children facing vulnerability, among other aspects described in the plan matrix – contributed to the eradication of child labour.
