Description:

To realise the rights of all children in accordance with the four core principles of the Convention on the Rights of the Child (CRC), non-discrimination, devotion to the best interests of the child, the right to life, survival and development, and respect for the views of the child.

Implementation plan:

The Office of the Children's Commissioner, OCC, has collaborated with UNICEF Malaysia to appoint a consultant to assist in working on its work plan from 2021 to 2025. This work plan will be the main guide for OCC to carry its duty to protect and empower child rights in Malaysia.

Impact:

By advocating, promoting, and monitoring issues to end child labour in Malaysia. One of the Office's duty is to monitor and investigate any violation of children's rights - including child labour.
