Ending Child Labour of Goods Imported into the U.S.

Description:

We will work to address child labour in the supply chain of products coming into the United States in two ways: one through an education campaign to raise awareness about child labour in the products we buy, particularly through chocolate; and two by following national legislation that will create stronger laws preventing importing products made with child labour.

Implementation plan:

We will begin by gathering data and resources about child labour in common products purchased by people in the United States, in particular chocolate. We will also share information about fair trade products which ensure no child labour as an ethical purchasing option. For the legislation, our advocacy team will look for national legislation that could positively impact preventing child labour in products, and when identified will encourage our members to contact their legislators in support.

Impact:

It will hopefully shift people's purchasing power to buy goods free of child labour and will support the creation of stronger laws to prevent companies from profiting off of child labour.
